SILVER LAKE BEACH RULES

- Please respect our lifeguards and follow their instructions.
- Parents are responsible for their own children.
- Children must not be left unattended.
- Children under age 14 must be accompanied by and supervised by an adult.
- Keep the beach area in front of the lifeguard station clear.
- Keep inside the perimeter lines.
- Keep in front of the raft in view of the lifeguards.
- Keep off the perimeter lines; lifeguards may take this as a sign that you need help.
- Use the ladder or the ramp to gain access to the raft or dock; do not try and push yourself up with your hands; you can slip and cause injury.
- A swimming test is required for deep water activity.
- Keep the dock clear of obstacles.
- No flips or twists off the raft or the dock
- No running on the raft or dock.
- No swimming under the dock or raft.
- No throwing of dirt or rocks.
- No diving into an inner tube.
- No fishing or feeding of the fish within the swimming area.
- Do not place anyone on your shoulders.
- No animals allowed on beach during dates of operation.
- No open fires or grilling of any kind except on the two town-owned charcoal grills.
- No vehicles of any kind on the beach.
- No motorboats on the lake.
- No alcoholic beverages.
- No smoking.
- No littering.
- We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

PERSONAL BOAT USE

Only canoes or boats that can be carried on car tops are allowed. No trailered watercrafts are allowed. Electronic outboard motors but no others may be used. [Click Here for the Use of Silver Lake bylaws.](#)

To access the lake:

- You may park in the beach parking lot during the operating season with a valid beach pass and must follow the Beach Rules and would need to remain in a restricted area.
- You may also launch from the road around the corner from the beach entrance and have access to the entire lake.
 - If you do launch from the road and boat to the beach, then you become our responsibility and must follow the Beach Rules.
